**Reading:** The children continue to work on strengthening their retelling abilities. We are working on reading for meaning. The children are practicing using character names when they talk about what happened in the story. We are also working on making sure we have events from the beginning, middle and end.

**Word Work**: We will wrap our study of the short i (big, wig, sit) next week. Then we will begin our final short vowel study of u (bug, rug, gut).

**Writing**: We wrapped our study of how authors bring their stories to life and began a study of ending our stories. We learned about one type of ending this week. It is called a circular ending, which means our opening line is repeated at the end of our story.

Math: We continue to learn strategies for solving addition and subtraction within 10. We are teaching each other the strategies we use when approaching a problem. The children are also learning about the importance of respectful mathematical discussions. We learned we can respectfully disagree and learn from mistakes.

Health: We continued our study of bones.
CPS Zoo Animal: We continued our study about tigers.

Integration: We are kicking off our major integration cycle about story elements through the study of fairy tales. The integration cycle is a special time of learning because children receive additional art and music minutes. During these minutes, I will be team teaching with the music and art



specialists!
