## Classroom Expectations

I am still regularly having to reteach and practice everyday first grade expectations. By this time of year, I am normally able to focus most of my attention on teaching the general curriculum. I would greatly appreciate you working with your children on listening attentively and following the directions the first time they are given. It would be helpful if you had this same expectation at home.

Tonight, Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM is the Lee PTA sponsored movie night. Families are invited to watch the PG movie Hocus Pocus in the school gym. Admission is free. There will be concessions available for purchase. Proceeds from the concessions will go to the PTA general funds account.

## Fall Festival

The Annual Lee Fall Festival is quickly approaching. Instead of celebrating Halloween, Lee has a Fall Festival for our children. This year's theme is "Spin a Story." The children will begin the day with a parade downtown. Then we will spend our day visiting different stations our Partners in Education hosts. These stations are extensions to our theme.

The children are invited to wear costumes this day. The costume should center around the grade level theme. This year first grade's theme is Fairy Tales. Be as creative as you want with your child's costume. Home-made costumes are always encouraged.

Literacy Night Be sure to check out the flyer in this week's folder about our annual Literacy Night.

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**Reading:** The children are working on strengthening their retelling abilities. We are working on reading for meaning. The children are practicing using character names when they talk about what happened in the story. We are also working on making sure we have events from the beginning, middle and end.

Word Work: We started reviewing the short vowel o in words like cot, mop, shop.

**Writing**: We are working on adding details to our stories. This week, we learned about making our characters move so that our stories come to life. Be sure to ask your child how they made their characters move in their narratives.

Math: We are working on using strategies to add and subtract within totals of 10. The children focused on moving from counting all (3+2 as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) to counting on (3+2 as hold 3 in head count 4, 5). We learned that addition and subtraction is when something changes. We learned how to use a change to more diagram for addition and a change to less diagram for subtraction.

Science: We continued our study about sound and light. Next week, we will make our own

instruments from recycled items. If you have recycled items please send them in with your child. Items may include cereal boxes, plastic bottles, rubber bands, toilet paper and paper towel tubes, etc. We may also need beans or rice for shakers.

### School Arrival and Dismissal

Remember that the children are allowed into the building at 7:35. There is no supervision before this time. The tardy bell rings at 7:55. That is the official start time to our day. If your child is a parent drop-off in the morning and you would like to have them eat breakfast you should plan to drop them as close to 7:35 as possible. This way they have time to eat their breakfast and be ready to learn at the start of our day. All children are expected to be here by then or they will be marked absent or tardy. We will dismiss buses first this year at 2:50 and then parent pick-up will start at 3:05.
