Literacy Night

Last week, there was a flyer about Literacy Night on November 14th from 6-7 PM. This is a great time for you to clean out your book collection and update it with gently used books. You can begin sending in gently used books with your child and I will give them a punch card to keep track of how many 'new' used books they can get the night of literacy night.

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Reading: The children continue to work on strengthening their retelling abilities. We are working on reading for meaning. The children are practicing using character names when they talk about what happened in the story. We are also working on making sure we have events from the beginning, middle and end.

Word Work: We continued our review of the short o (mop, pot, dots, spot). We will finish with short o and begin the short i next week.

Writing: We are working on adding details to our stories. This week, we reviewed making our characters move and learned how to make our characters talk.

Math: We are working on using strategies to add and subtract within totals of 10. The children focused on moving from counting all (3+2 as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) to counting on (3+2 as hold 3 in head

count 4, 5). We learned that addition and subtraction is when something changes. We learned how to use a change to more diagram for addition and a change to less diagram for subtraction. Science: We wrapped up our study of sound. We will spend a few days learning about light. CPS Zoo Animal: We learned all about the kangaroo. A kangaroo is a marsupial which means it has a pouch for its baby. We also learned that a baby kangaroo is called a joey.

School Arrival and Dismissal

Remember that the children are allowed into the building at 7:35. There is no supervision before this time. The tardy bell rings at 7:55. That is the official start time to our day. If your child is a parent drop-off in the morning and you would like to have them eat breakfast you should plan to drop them as close to 7:35 as possible. This way they have time to eat their breakfast and be ready to learn at the start of our day. All children are expected to be here by then or they will be marked absent or tardy. We will dismiss buses first this year at 2:50 and then parent pick-up will start at 3:05.
