## Literacy Night

Last week, there was a flyer about Literacy Night on November 14th from 6-7 PM. This is a great time for you to clean out your book collection and update it with gently used books. You can begin sending in gently used books with your child and I will give them a punch card to keep track of how many 'new' used books they can get the night of literacy night.

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**Reading:** The children continue to work on strengthening their retelling abilities. We are working on reading for meaning. The children are practicing using character names when they talk about what happened in the story. We are also working on making sure we have events from the beginning, middle and end.

Word Work: We began our review of the short vowel i like in pig, wig, sit. We will wrap our study next week.

**Writing:** We are working on adding details to our stories. We reviewed all the strategies for making our stories come to life. These include making our characters move, making our character talk, sharing our characters feelings, and sharing our characters thoughts.

Math: We are working on using strategies to add and subtract within totals of 10. The children focused on moving from counting all (3+2 as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) to counting on (3+2 as hold 3 in head count 4, 5). We learned that addition and subtraction is when something changes. We learned how to use a change to more diagram for addition and a change to less diagram for subtraction. Health: We began our study about bones. Children will learn the importance of bones and how to keep our bones healthy.

CPS Zoo Animal: We are so excited to have the Tiger visiting us! We all believe he must be friends with Truman the Tiger. We could not believe that tiger cubs only stay with their mother for 2 years.

## School Arrival and Dismissal

Remember that the children are allowed into the building at 7:35. There is no supervision before this time. The tardy bell rings at 7:55. That is the official start time to our day. If your child is a parent drop-off in the morning and you would like to have them eat breakfast you should plan to drop them as close to 7:35 as possible. This way they have time to eat their breakfast and be ready to learn at the start of our day. All children are expected to be here by then or they will be marked absent or tardy. We will dismiss buses first this year at 2:50 and then parent pick-up will start at 3:05.
