#### Fall Festival

The Annual Lee Fall Festival is quickly approaching. Instead of celebrating Halloween, Lee has a Fall Festival for our children. This year's theme is "Spin a Story." The children will begin the day with a parade downtown. Then we will spend our day visiting different stations our Partners in Education hosts. These stations are extensions to our theme.

The children are invited to wear costumes this day. The costume should center around the grade level theme. This year first grade's theme is Fairy Tales. Be as creative as you want with your child's costume. Homemade costumes are always encouraged.

#### Mystery Reader

If you are interested in being a mystery reader for our classroom please feel free to contact me to set up a date and time for you to visit. A mystery reader is a great way for us to work together to show children how fun and important reading is. When you come as a mystery reader, you are a guest reader in our classroom. You are welcome to bring your own picture book to read aloud to the class. The children really enjoy mystery readers!

**Reading:** The children are adding weekly poems to the poetry books during literacy stations. The poems are perfect practice fluency and expression while reading. It also reinforces our short vowel sound and word wall work. **Please be on the lookout for just right books to come home in backpacks in the next few weeks.** Children will need to read their book on the evening it comes home and return it to school the following morning.

**Word Work**: We reviewed the short u sound like in the words cup, bus, duck.

**Writing**: We learned there is a process for writing. This week, we worked on rereading our stories and deciding if we should add our classmates wonderings (questions) to provide more detail in our narratives. **Math**: We are working on using strategies to add and subtract within totals of 10. The children

focused on moving from counting all (3+2 as 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) to counting on (3+2 as hold 3 in head count 4, 5). We are also working on using 10 frames to add and subtract. Be sure to have your child share what a ten frame is!

Science: We started a study of light and sound. Children are eager to build instruments using recycled items. However, before we can build instruments we have to study how sound is made. This week, we realized that in order for sound to occur there has to be vibrations.

CPS Zoo Animal: We studied the octopus this week. We were really shocked to learn that octopuses

could squeeze into tight spaces because they have NO bones!

Remember that the children are allowed into the building at 7:35. There is no supervision before this time. The tardy bell rings at 7:55. That is the official start time to our day.
